Safety & Outdoor & Other Needs

2 Shower doors; 30m Fence and 6 Sensor lights

Renovation - Painting / Tiling/Roofsheets/ Cement Slab

2 x 20 litre Grey & White washable paint -PVA
1 x 5 litre –DTM/ Hammerite Paint -white and Black
Floor tiles for passage 25-28 sqm with tiling grout
5 cement bags/ 3 stone bags/ 3 white sand bags for concrete stoep

Kitchen needs

Microwave 20 litre – R 3 000
2 door fridge – R 16 000
Freezer – R 17 500
Shelving in Pantry – R 3 600
1.5m - 2m Stainless Steel table – R 4 000
Industrial Gas stove/Fryer – R 26 000
