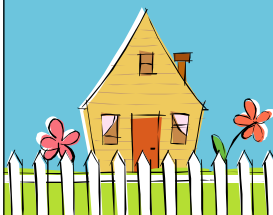

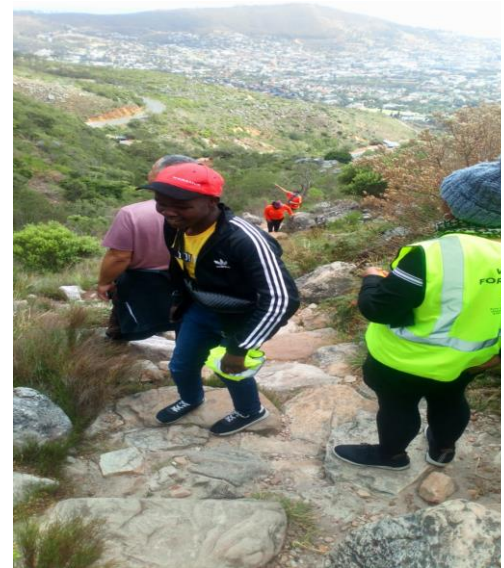
## THE YEAR AHEAD - 2021
